

Tier 2: Basic Adult Training

Group Class:

Our group classes are held at a various location and include up to 12 other dogs. You will be taught in a train the trainer approach. Your dog will learn sit, down, stay and come when called. Group classes are a great way to socialize your dog with other dogs and train with distractions. As in all situations, your safety and that of your companion is our top priority. Any dog that displays excessive dog aggression in the group setting will be asked to continue their training on a private one on one style class. These classes are held once a week. 3 dogs minimum and 12 maximum.

Private Lessons:

These classes are taught in a one-on-one setting with one of our qualified trainers either at your home or at our facility. The class offers you the undivided attention of the instructor to ensure your companion is taking to the training and enables immediate problem solving. The training is conducted one day a week in your home or at a designated location. This program is designed to be hands on with the owner. We will teach you techniques to help you achieve your desired result. In these sessions your dog will learn sit, down, stay and come when called. These tasks will be performed on leash or off leash for more advanced dogs.

Board and Train:

Basic:

Our board and train program are a comprehensive package that allows you to drop your dog off with us for 30-45 days of training. This training package will teach your dog sit, down, stay, come when called and basic manners on leash or from a short distance. We use a variety of positive motivational methods to train your dog. We will also work on advanced skills which include off leash tasks. Our training staff will go over packages with you to help you decide which is the best fit for you. Your trainer will keep you up to date on your dog while in our care. ***All training is perishable if not continued. During the training, we ask that you refrain from visiting your dog. When owners visit it has the potential to prolong training. Weekly updates will be sent on your dog's progress.***
